


Fell the Forest of Faxes;

A Greener Faxing Workflow



Contrary to popular opinion, faxing continues to be an important aspect of conducting daily business. For businesses such as healthcare providers, estate agents and financial services companies, fax usage remains high for the quick exchange of documents and authorisation retrieval. In addition, the Health and Social Care Information Centre (HSCIC) and other regulations governing data privacy have increased the need for documents containing personally identifiable information to be created and saved securely.

To find an alternative fax method, look for what are generally referred to as digital cloud faxing, faxing by email, or digital fax solutions. These services offer far more features and capabilities than traditional faxing.

For example, a significant benefit of digital cloud faxing is that employees can send and receive faxes by email. Whether you're waiting for a meeting to begin, holding a mobile device while you're talking with colleagues, networking at a business function, travelling or sitting in your office, digital cloud faxing lets you access important business faxes anywhere — from any desktop, laptop or mobile device.

Another major benefit digital cloud faxing offers: every employee can get his or her own dedicated fax number. The best-in-class providers will offer a choice of local, freephone and even international fax numbers.

Moreover, a digital cloud fax solution not only eliminates the need for a dedicated fax phone line, but also saves you the costs of hardware and fax supplies. Businesses can control their costs even more by monitoring individual usage, as the best digital cloud fax providers offer robust and centralised fax management through an intuitive administrative portal. Finally, productivity often increases because employees no longer have to spend time maintaining machines or waiting endlessly for a paper fax transmission.

Protecting customer privacy within an organisation is key, particularly in today's highly regulated environment governed by the UK Data Protection Act of 1998, HSCIC for healthcare organisations, and similar regulations for businesses in other industries. That's why providing employees with their own dedicated fax numbers is one of the other major benefits of digital cloud faxing. Cloud-based fax transmissions, which with the best providers are encrypted using the most advanced standards, offer unparalleled privacy — whereas traditional faxes often arrive in full view of anyone who happens to be near a fax machine.

Having realised the need for a digital cloud faxing solution in their organisations, many companies have chosen to install their own fax systems.
